In November we remember our dead. We pray for them that they may have the fullness of life. We start however with the feast of All Saints, that great cry of triumph as we glory in the saints who have gone before us.

Remembering our Recent Dead, Arnside, Vigil Mass: We remember the dead from both our parishes at this Mass (broadcasted).

Remembrance Sunday: Next Sunday. Please see list of cenotaph services. All are held outside.

Keeping Faith



This Sunday's Scripture All Saints.

November starts with a great statement of hope for the future in the feast of All Saints. We celebrate all the good people who have now fulfilled God's plan and have come home to Him in Heaven. We think first of all of the great saints outstanding in holiness and witness to God. We also remember our call to be saints in heaven. On Tuesday we celebrate a great Saint, Charles Borromeo,

Archbishop of Milan. With courage, vision and zeal he helped make the vital Council of Trent happen, whilst serving his people faithfully.

All Souls, Monday 2nd November: On the feast of All Souls we remember all those who have not denied God, but who know they are not yet ready to see God face to face. We help them with our prayers to come to God in peace and joy.

Grange Cemetery visit and graveside Service; (meet 2.00pm Grange Cemetery entrance).

Remembering our Dead: November is the month when we remember our dead. We will remember our dead of the last year at the vigil Mass of All Saints, Halloween. Halloween means ‘the evening of all the hallowed or holy ones’. It is a time when we feel particularly close to those who have died, divided from us by the veil of death. It is particularly poignant this year, as we have not been able to see many who have died, as we would have liked, because of Covid restrictions. Additionally their funerals have had to be simple and brief family funerals.

November Lists: you are reminded that November is the month of the Holy Souls. We remember our faithful departed and pray for them at each Mass. Some Masses will be dedicated to the Holy Souls. If you want a Mass said for a particular intention, please make a separate Mass request. If you have not already done so, take an envelope and put it in the basket on the altar.

Grange, Feast of St. Charles: (4 November, but celebrated Tuesday 3rd November at St Charles Church)

St Charles died November 3, 1584, Milan; A cardinal and archbishop who was one of the most important figures of the Counter-Reformation in Italy. Saint Charles spent his life and fortune in the service of the people of his diocese. He directed and fervently enforced the decrees of the Council of Trent, fought tirelessly for peace in the wake of the storm caused by Martin Luther, founded schools, seminaries, and hospitals for the sick, conducted synods, and worked among the sick and dying, leading his people by example. A picture of St. Charles will be brought forward at the beginning of the Tuesday Mass at Grange.

Broadcasts: I remind you that Mass is broadcasted each day at or shortly before 11am. I give a short reflection on the readings, so that we can nourish our spiritual life on the scriptures of the day. Search in You Tube under ‘Kent Estuary Catholic Churches’ or join our Facebook.

Christ the King: 22nd November, the feast of Christ the King, we celebrate also 50 years since the construction of the Church of Christ the King in Milnthorpe.
