I have never experienced that particular phenomenon of the Holy Spirit. However what I did experience was a strong but gentle breeze. It seemed to envelop me with a deep love and peace. Now, 35 years on when I pray to Him, He still comes as that peaceful, gentle breeze - comforting, guiding, and helping me with all the situations in my life.
